- “Most recently communications regarding Covid in nursery in the initial comms could of been handled better, very late notification. Not specific enough with regards to the actual year group affected, it was only through our own contacts with other parents did we find out on the Sunday night it was nursery. We have two children at Bruche so at that point we didn’t know which chid had to stay at home.”

School response:

Thanks for your comment. Below is the first text message we sent out on Sunday evening to inform our nursery parents that the nursery bubble was closing.

*‘Sincere apologies, but after taking advice we need to close our Nursery bubble from now because we have had a positive test from a child... Please don't attend school tomorrow. I will send out further info tomorrow by email.’*

- “There seems to be a lot of conflict between the children in \*\*\*\*\* at the moment. It is having some massive impacts on the children. It is being raised and raised by it is continuing. I am not sure if you do bullying awareness classes but something is needed”

School response:

Unfortunately we don’t have a name to respond to this directly. Please get in touch with school to discuss this further as we don’t feel there are bullying issues in the class you have mentioned.

- Since going back to school there is an increase in bad behaviour from name calling and fighting and doesn’t seem that much is been getting done about it or parents being contacted. Would have been nice when the children returned to school to make a fuss with banner/balloons etc like other schools did



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School response:

Unfortunately we don't have a name to respond to this directly. On returning to school we really just wanted to keep everything as normal as possible for all of our children which is why we didn't put up banners and balloons. We have all been so pleased and proud of how well children have settled into school in September.

- "My child isn't as happy at school now with the restrictions put in place and lack of running around time at lunch and break time and basically the lack of anything fun. I understand you're ticking boxes but there is very little risk of becoming ill with this virus if you actually looked at the figures on the government website, so some leniency with regards to the rules should be practised to make Bruche the leader in Warrington as it formerly was"

School Response:

Thank you for your comment. We are working hard every day to make sure our classes stay open for as long as possible. Unfortunately this means we must follow guidance about children not mixing classes outside. Each class has their own dedicated area to play in. PE and Art lessons have continued from September in all classes.

- "No child should be punished by missing their break. Ever."
